Project Description/Justification:

The department currently has outdated body scanners within several prisons. These scanners are used to scan inmates and staff as they enter the facility to search for contraband in clothing and body cavities. The current scanners are more than six years old and have outdated technology. With improved scanning technology, the department will be better able to detect contraband in body cavities and prevent its introduction into the prisons.

This project will update the body scanners located at: Anchorage Correctional Complex (2), Goose Creek Correctional Center (2), Spring Creek Correctional Center, Hiland Mountain Correctional Center, and Wildwood Correctional Center and includes the body scanners, shipping, installation, and associated costs to ensure staff are properly trained and fully knowledgeable in use of the new equipment.
