Completed the effort to fully integrate the Offender classification and transportation units into the Alaska Corrections Offender Management System (ACOMS)

Deployed BizTalk solution to provide offender mugshot photos to the Department of Public Safety.

Refactored the ACOMS User Administration functionality to enable trained Terminal Security Officers (TSOs) to enter and maintain their own local user base within ACOMS.

Continued efforts with ACOMS system security enhancements to meet Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) standards.
