Project Description/Justification:

The Department provides the required match funding based on the estimated federal funding that will be available during the given fiscal year. The estimated amount needed to fund the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2021 Federal Aviation Improvement Program is based on the amount of federal funds expected to be appropriated by Congress for FFY 2021.

The requested match amount is calculated as follows:

Rural Airport Program

\$140.0 million in federal funds requires a 6.25% state match \$140.0 million / 93.75% = \$149.3 (program total including match amount) \$149.3 million - \$140.0 million = \$9.3 million match requirement
