





Major Component Accomplishments in 2019

• Completed the annual regulatory update of the *Catalog of Waters Important for the Spawning, Rearing, or Migration of Anadromous Fishes* (anadromous means fish that live in saltwater but spawn in freshwater).

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This catalog identifies and provides information to applicants regarding streams subject to statutory provisions and the need for an AS 16.05.871 permit to conduct work in those listed waterbodies.

- Drafted the Alaska Department of Fish & Game (ADF&G) section of the Department of Natural Resources Commissioner's Analysis for the Donlin Gold proposed gas pipeline State right-of-way application and participated in several public hearings held in various communities potentially affected by the gas pipeline.
- Worked with the public and industry to review and issue Fish Habitat and Special Area permits in a timely manner. Each permit decision was guided by site specific factors and best available science to both properly protect fish habitat while still allowing responsible development. The average time to complete a Fish Habitat Permit was 7.0 days recognizing that some permits are issued quickly while some may be in the review process for over a year before a final application is completed.
- Performed ongoing aquatic biomonitoring at several large mine projects, including: Fort Knox, Kensington, Red Dog, Greens Creek, and Lemon Creek.
- Performed baseline aquatic biomonitoring at mine prospects: Constantine Palmer, Arctic Bornite, and Anarraaq-Aktigiruq.
- Worked on ongoing permitting and environmental reviews for North Slope oil and gas projects, Trans Alaska Pipeline System, Alaska Liquid Natural Gas (LNG) Pipeline, and Alaska Stand Alone Pipeline.
- Worked on permitting and environmental reviews for Donlin, Pebble, Anarraaq-Aktigiruq, and Constantine Palmer hard-rock prospects.
- Worked on permitting and environmental reviews for Ambler Industrial Road, Haines Highway upgrade, and Katlian Bay Road.
- Conducted preliminary field work for the Kake to Petersburg Access Road.
- Permit issuance will continue for in-river hydro on Kvichak River.
- Provided expertise on fish passage issues to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities on various highway projects (Dalton, Haines, and others).
- Participated in the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities Wildlife Working Group.
- Represented the ADF&G in the Federal Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) process for large projects such as the proposed Pebble Prospect, Arctic National Wildlife Refuge 1002 oil and gas, Willow, Ambler Industrial Road, and Alaska LNG.
- Completed numerous trip reports documenting pre-project and post-project field inspections.
- Updated and closed out, where possible, compliance actions.
- Conducted applied field research to support permitting, monitoring/compliance, and rehabilitation.
- Completed technical reports pertaining to Red Dog, Fort Knox, Greens Creek, and Kensington mines, Constantine Palmer and Arctic-Bornite prospects, and surveys of anadromous waterbodies.
- Under the Forest Resource Practices Act (FRPA) reviewed timber harvest plans, conducted field inspections, and worked cooperatively with timber operators.
- Continued work on Special Area Plans including Kachemak Bay and Fox River Flats and Willow Mountain.
- Participated in multiple oil spill drills and provided comments on Oil Spill Contingency Plans.

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• Participated in the state's transboundary mines effort.

Key Component Challenges

Habitat's key component challenge is to ensure that at current staffing levels, the section continues to provide meaningful conservation of important fish and wildlife resources and habitats and issue permits for responsible resource development in a timely manner. Maintaining staff expertise continues to be a challenge. This will continue for the foreseeable future and has the potential to adversely affect review of major development projects.

Habitat relies on statutorily designated program receipts to fund staff time for most of the major development projects. This has worked but is entirely dependent upon industries' continued interest in funding the work.


