RDU/Component: Human Rights Commission

Contribution to Department's Mission

The Alaska Constitution provides that "all persons are equal and entitled to equal rights, opportunities, and protection under the law; and that all persons have corresponding obligations to the people and to the State." Alaska Constitution Article I, § 1. "No person is to be denied the enjoyment of any civil or political right because of race, color, creed, sex, or national origin. The legislature shall implement this section." *Id.* art. I, § 3.

The Alaska State Commission for Human Rights (ASCHR) works to prevent and eliminate discrimination in employment, in credit and financing practices, in places of public accommodation, in the sale, lease, or rental of real property, and in practices by the state or its political subdivisions because of race, religion, color, national origin, sex, age, physical or mental disability, marital status, changes in marital status, pregnancy, or parenthood.

Core Services

- ASCHR enforces the Human Rights Law to prevent and eliminate discrimination through mediation, impartial investigation of complaints, conciliation, adjudication, public education and community outreach.
- Accept and investigate complaints where State jurisdiction exists.
- Informally resolve discrimination complaints through mediation, conciliation, and settlement.
- Resolve cases adjudicated at administrative hearings.
- Provide public education regarding Alaskans' civil rights.
- Collaborate with other organizations and members of the community to help reduce problems resulting from discrimination in Alaska through referrals, joint programs and participation in existing initiatives.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2019

- There is no longer a substantial case backlog; no case in investigation is more than two years old.
- All tactics have been completed in the initial five-year strategic plan (within a two-year time-frame) and the Commission is working on a second plan to focus future efforts on statewide outreach.
- Implemented a new case management system that shortened case processing time.
- ASCHR continues to focus on training for legal staff and investigators to process cases more efficiently and effectively.
- The ASCHR website has been updated to reflect changes in technology and incorporate electronic signature as a complaint transmittal form.
- ASCHR's outreach committee is working on a marketing plan to reach out to vulnerable populations statewide. Outreach includes traditional media, social media and in person trainings and listening sessions.
- ASCHR's mediation program provided Alaska businesses and complainants the opportunity to voluntarily and quickly reach a mutually acceptable resolution to claims of discrimination without investigation.
- ASCHR introduced regulations increasing the jurisdictional timeframe (equivalent to a statute of limitations) from 180 days to 300 days, added a service animal regulation, and established a protocol for confidential witness interviews (as proposed by the Alaska Supreme Court).

Key Component Challenges

- The Commission's renewed goal of expanded outreach efforts requires that it find cost savings in other areas to finance travel to rural communities to reach vulnerable populations.
- Creating a positive public perception for the ASCHR.
- Rebuilding staff and institutional knowledge after a complete change in staff attorneys, several supervisors and a lengthy period without a permanent Executive Director.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

FY2021 Governor Office of the Governor

Component — Human Rights Commission

- Rebuild a quality workforce by hiring top level, skilled individuals who can meet the agency's demands, commensurate with an organizational review and restructuring to find cost savings.
- Keeping the agency free of backlog will require education and training for new staff, with consistent pressure on thorough yet timely investigations and legal review.
- Complete investigations within one year, with the ultimate goal of completing all investigations within 180 days.
- Continuing to implement technology throughout the organization, including a secondary review of the existing
 case management system, switching to a VOIP phone system, and creating a plan for digital archives to
 move toward a more modern and paperless office environment.
- Explore opportunities to create a semi-private searchable database of precedential Commission decisions for use by all legal practitioners that will increase the internal attorney staff's efficiency.
- Ongoing edits to the strategic plan that will focus Commission efforts on education and enforcement to ensure it is addressing its mission.
- Create white papers and reports regarding the effects of discrimination on the residents of Alaska.
- Draft a legal manual related to the ASCHR's jurisdiction, claim elements, process, etc.
- Using existing staff, establish a grant program to apply for grants from federal and non-profit agencies that will reduce the need for General Fund expenditures.
- Review regulations to remove unnecessary provisions.
- Consider potential statutory changes that could result in additional federal reimbursement and/or as otherwise requested by the Commission.

RDU/Component: Elections

Contribution to Department's Mission

To ensure public confidence in the electoral process by administering voter registration and elections with the highest level of professional standards, integrity, security, accuracy and fairness.

Core Services

- Oversee voter registration. Update and maintain voter records and prepare voter rolls for local and statewide elections.
- Plan, prepare and conduct two statewide elections during even numbered years. Conduct Regional Educational
 Attendance Area (REAA) elections yearly. Conduct local liquor option, incorporation, consolidation, dissolution,
 recall, and special elections as required by law.
- Oversee and support the initiative petition process including signature verification and printing and distribution of petition books. Provide training and assist petition sponsors from the time the initiative is proposed through certification for placement on the ballot, or non-certification.
- Improve the efficiency and accessibility of the electoral process.
- Maintain the Voter Registration and Election Management System (VREMS).
- Improve accuracy of the voter registration list.
- · Plan and prepare for future elections.
- Encourage higher voter participation.
- Continue implementation of changes mandated by the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), the Uniformed and Overseas Citizen Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA), Military and Overseas Voter Empowerment Act (MOVE), and the National Voter Registration Act (NVRA).
- Continue implementation of Permanent Fund Dividend Automatic Voter Registration (PFD-AVR).

Major Component Accomplishments in 2019

- Awarded a contract for a new voting and ballot tabulation system.
- Convened the Election Policy Work Group for a meeting to provide an update on the voting and ballot tabulation system, election security, language compliance, election legislation, initiatives, PFD-AVR, HAVA funding and election worker recruitment and retention.
- Managed all aspects of the implementation of PFD-AVR, processing 344,210 PFD Auto and Manual voter registration applications to date. Of that number, 16,910 were new registrations and 327,300 were updates or simply voter contact.
- In 2019, overall voter registration activity is 395,724 with 30,620 new registrations and 365,464 updates or voter contact.
- Completed enhancements to the division's statewide VREMS online voter registration portal and website to make it more user-friendly and accessible.
- Conducted the REAA elections.
- In accordance with the NVRA and state law, the division performed voter list maintenance and moved 19,447 voters to inactive status.
- Processed four initiative petition applications for circulation and one recall petition application.
- Continued improvements to the division's language assistance program to comply with the requirements outlined in the settlement of the *Toyukak* case and Section 203 of the Federal Voting Rights Act.
- Improved online accessibility through language-appropriate webpages.
- Improved internal workflows and processes through the build out of databases and streamlining translation materials.
- Made continued improvements to the division's procedure for tracking felony convictions with the Alaska Court System.
- Continued membership in the Electronic Registration Information Center to improve the accuracy of voter rolls and increase voter registration. To date, 6,636 registrations have been cancelled through the cross-state matching program.
- Redesign of the division's website.

 Implemented new protocols to further secure the division's Voter Registration system and ballot tabulations system.

Key Component Challenges

- Managing the implementation of PFD-AVR with no additional funding or staff resources.
- Faced with diminishing HAVA federal funds, maintaining the current level of service to voters and the administration of Alaska elections including mandatory language assistance
- In the 2016 presidential general election, 103,858 (32%) voted an absentee or early ballot. In the 2018 gubernatorial election, 84,414 voters (30%) voted an absentee or early ballot. The division anticipates an increase during the 2020 presidential general election.
- Modernizing voting technology without compromising auditability and security.
- Managing the division's workload which has increased due to federal and state legal mandates and new security requirements for voter registration, list maintenance, ballot programming, equipment maintenance, functional testing, logic and accuracy testing, training on the voting equipment and deployment of over 800 voting units.
- The continuing improvements and ongoing maintenance that ensure compliance with the *Toyukak* settlement requires an on-going search for, and engagement with, Alaska Native language speakers who have the skill and availability to translate election information and materials.
- Finding and hiring a Language Program Project Coordinator who can generate seed translations and also help manage the program's logistical and administrative tasks has proven to be challenging and time-consuming.
- The complexity of ballot measure language and the unknown number of ballot measures create challenges for meeting deadlines and means that some materials in the translated Official Election Pamphlet may not be fully realized.
- The number of translation materials varies year to year, making budgeting a challenge. In spite of the diminishing HAVA funds, the state's obligation to provide this assistance remains a requirement. The translation requirements are not only for languages under the *Toyukak* settlement, but also those covered by the Federal Voting Rights Act, Section 203 determinations; this includes translations in 15 current languages in the program, and at minimum 12 more that we are not currently covering.
- Recruiting and retaining bilingual speakers to serve as outreach and poll workers for Alaska Native, Tagalog
 and Spanish languages. The division is required to find fluent speakers in 15 languages presently, but that
 number can easily increase as the Section 203 determinations dictate.
- Recruitment, training and retention of election workers for the division's 441 precincts and 170 absentee voting locations.
- Managing an increasing number of public records requests.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

- Implementation of a new voting and ballot tabulation system for the 2020 elections.
- Continue improvements to the division's language assistance program and compliance with the requirements outlined in the settlement of the *Toyukak* case and Section 203 of the Federal Voting Rights Act.
- Improved accessibility and ongoing maintenance of translations in 15 languages.
- Developing new language processes to help facilitate the implementation of the new voting and ballot tabulation system.
- Increased robustness of language panels and develop strategies to transition and manage the composition of the panels.
- Continue improvements to the division's statewide training program for election workers.
- Refine procedures for data transfer with the Permanent Fund Dividend Division and the processing of voter records through PFD Automatic Voter Registration.
- Implementation of an online tool for absentee by-mail application.
- Improving online tools for voters to look up their registration information, including directions to their assigned polling place and absentee ballot status.
- Continued improvements to enhance security of election systems.

Statutory and Regulatory Authority
