- Handles probation revocation actions, all sentence and sufficiency of evidence appeals and most post-conviction relief proceedings.
- Participates in specialized court and probation programs.
- Provides victim-witness assistance services such as: information on court procedures required by statute and the Alaska Constitution; applying for restitution; arrangement of travel and payment for expenses and court-mandated witness fees: assistance with domestic violence orders and violent crimes compensation procedures; and preparation of victims and witnesses to testify in court.
