 preparation of victims and witnesses to testify in court.

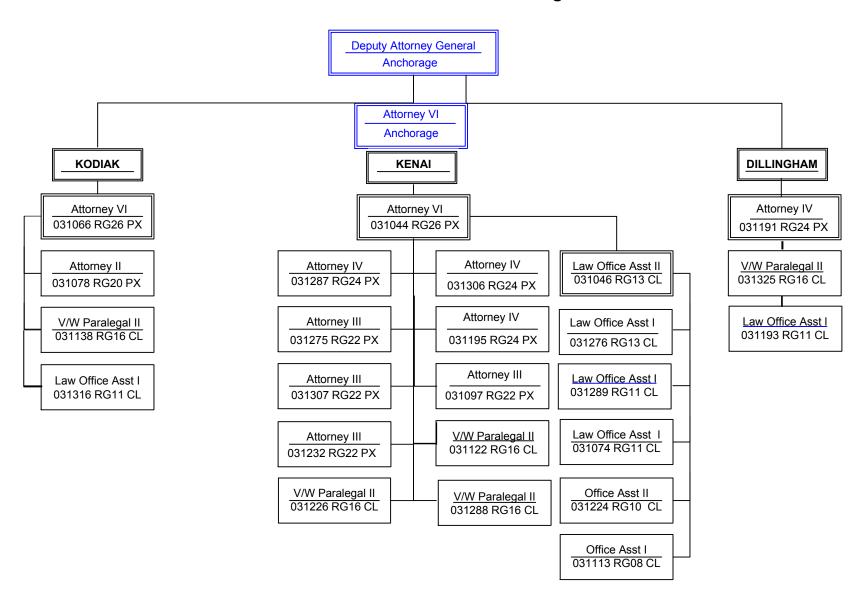
