Contribution to Department's Mission

This component contributes to the department's mission by providing legal services that support the efforts of criminal justice agencies, and by providing policy direction for and direct supervision of the Criminal Division.

Core Services

- Provides general legal services to the Department of Corrections relating to its criminal justice activities. These
 legal services consist of verbal and written advice, representation in civil litigation and administrative proceedings,
 and assistance with drafting legislation, regulations, policies and procedures.
- Provides general legal advice and services to the Department of Public Safety including representation in civil litigation, and assistance with drafting legislation, regulations, policies, and procedures. Funding is through a reimbursable services agreement with the Department of Public Safety.
- Advises the governor and the legislature on criminal justice legislation.
- Provides overall administration of the Criminal Division and sets policy for all offices in the Criminal Division by
 monitoring and approving budgetary expenditures, setting uniform prosecution policies, maintaining a case
 management system, recruiting and direct personnel management.
