2 DEVELOPMENT. (a) The amount of the fees collected under AS 28.10.421(d) during the
3 fiscal years ending June 30, 2017, June 30, 2018, June 30, 2019, June 30, 2020, for the
4 issuance of special request Blood Bank of Alaska plates, less the cost of issuing the license
5 plates, estimated to be \$2,265, is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of
6 Commerce, Community, and Economic Development for payment as a grant under
7 AS 37.05.316 to the Blood Bank of Alaska for support of their mission for the fiscal year
8 ending June 30, 2021.
