Major Component Accomplishments in 2019

• The Criminal Justice Information Systems Program (CJISP) Security Team made significant progress in ensuring compliance with state and federal criminal justice information security policies. The team saw a decrease of 11% over FY2018 in the number of security clearances for criminal justice employees, contractors, and information technology staff; however, they still processed 2,300 requests. The team completed 92 of 93 non-criminal justice CJIS User Agreements with customers requesting criminal history record background checks for employment and licensing purposes; during the audit process the team closed out or consolidated almost 50 inactive clients.

- Additionally, audits have been conducted on 72 of the 93 agencies during FY2019, with the remaining agency audits scheduled for completion during the first half of FY2020.
- Federal grant funding was secured under the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) Act Record Improvement Program (NARIP) in FY2018 to implement programming changes to the criminal history repository and to hire four long term, non-permanent positions to enable the Criminal Justice Information Services Program to meet federal requirements to report certain misdemeanor crimes of domestic violence convictions which disqualify individuals from the transfer or possession of firearms. During FY2019, two of the four positions were hired, trained, and have initiated the extensive research project to obtain case information on known domestic violence convictions and to determine if the perpetrator meets federal domestic relationship standards, triggering the prohibition. Once identified, disqualified individuals will have their descriptive information entered into the NICS Indices. A contractor has also been retained and has begun working to make necessary programming changes to the criminal history repository to allow this information to be retained in the state system as well, and it will enable automating the submission of records under the scope of this project to the NICS Indices and the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBIs) Interstate Identification Index, which is the national criminal history repository.
- Federal grant funding secured in FY2018 under the National Crime Statistics Exchange (NCS-X) program has been used to hire a contractor to develop an interim solution to process National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS) crime statistics submitted by local law enforcement agencies until a statewide NIBRS repository could be implemented at the state level. The FBI has mandated they will only accept NIBRS data for crime statistic submission to the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) program effective 1/1/2021; state and local law enforcement agencies are required to submit UCR data to the Department of Public Safety under AS12.62.130. The Criminal Justice Information Services Program completed a request for proposal for a NIBRS repository to replace the existing Summary Based Reporting system; due to the significantly different data collection formats and reporting requirements, the existing system cannot be modified sufficiently to collect the NIBRS information. A vendor contract and project implementation is scheduled for completion in FY2020, allowing the state to comply with the FBI mandate and to collect much more expansive and beneficial crime statistic data such as victim offender relationships, time of offense occurrences, locations of crime occurrences, and a correlation to offenses committed and any subsequent arrests for those offenses.
- The Criminal Justice Information Services Program also created a new unit to audit state trooper case reports for UCR data collection and to assess and test the Alaska Records Management System (ARMS) for NIBRS. A team of six, which includes a unit supervisor, has been hired and trained on state and federal UCR requirements under both the NIBRS and Summary Reporting System formats to allow for current and future data collection efforts. The ARMS application is used by the state troopers as well as several other state and local law enforcement agencies. While the new unit will provide training and assistance to each agency on issues related to obtaining NIBRS data from ARMS; the team will specifically research and report this data for the state troopers.
- The Alaska Automated Biometric Identification System (ABIS) team implemented a new training program for fingerprint technicians to resolve the historical issue of recruitment and retention challenges for these positions. Prior to implementing the 12-month training program, these positions often had to be recruited out of state. In FY2019, the two training positions have been filled, with the first 'graduate' of the program transitioning to the full proficiency fingerprint technician position; the second training position is scheduled to complete the training program in early FY2020. Once both training positions transition to full proficiency positions, the training program will be on hold, pending vacancies of either of the full proficiency positions. The training program increased productivity in the unit and eliminated overtime which was a recurring issue due to the recruitment and retention issues to maintain a full staff.

Key Component Challenges

In June 2019, the Alaska Supreme Court ruled that sex offenders are entitled to the opportunity to argue for early release from registration and reporting requirements. In order to obtain early release, offenders must do and prove the following: first, the offender must file a civil action in the Superior Court requesting a hearing. Second, at the hearing, the offender must present evidence that he or she no longer "poses a risk to the public that justifies continued registration." With this ruling, the Sex Offender Registration Office is working with the Department of Law on how to implement an early release from registration process, a process which may involve statutory changes. They are also working diligently to address questions from registrants, their attorneys, the media, and the public.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

The Bureau will continue building the project and allow for the collection and reporting of more robust crime statistics.

The Bureau will ensure that subjects disqualified under federal law from possessing or transferring firearms are unable to purchase those firearms.

The Bureau will ensure sex offenders are provided an opportunity to petition for early release from registration and reporting requirements.

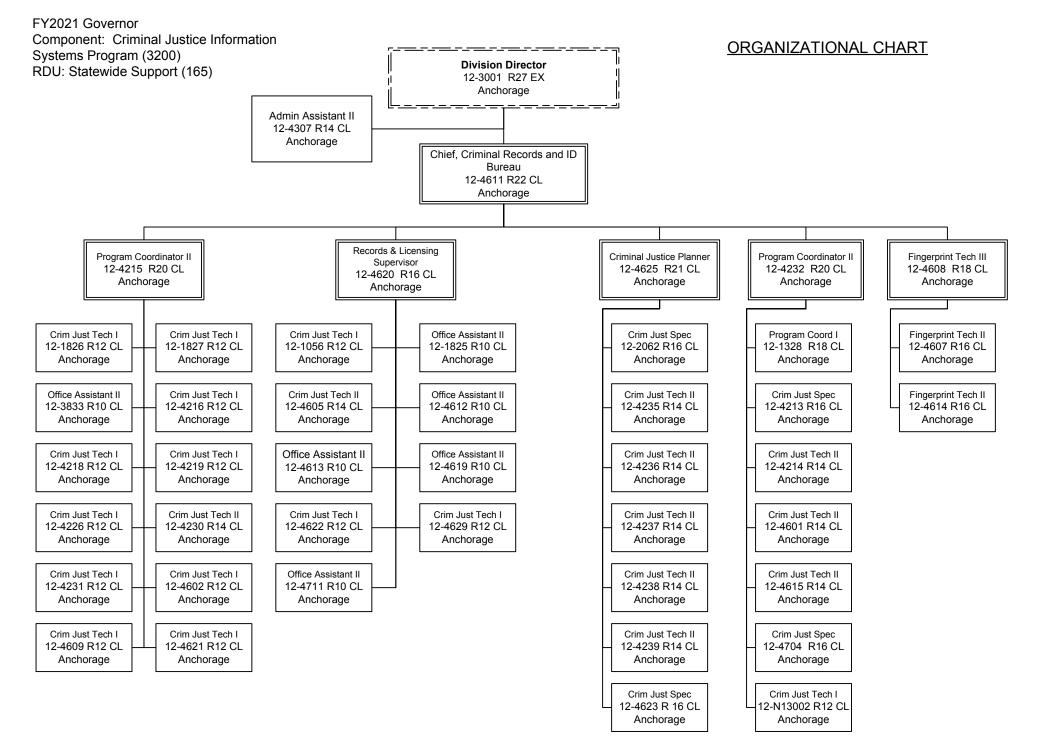
