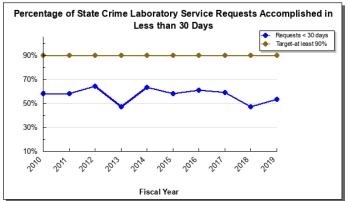

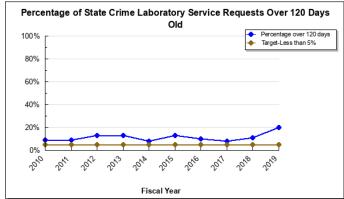

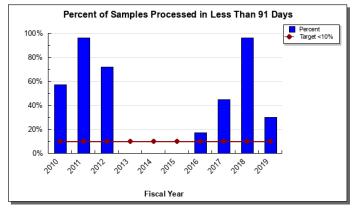

### **Major Component Accomplishments in 2019**

A total of 3,636 database samples (16% increase over FY2018) and 242 forensic profiles (from submitted cases – a 76% increase over FY2018) were entered into the DNA database with the following results:

- 3 forensic hits (linking currently unsolved cases).
- 118 instances of a suspect being identified in an unsolved Alaska case (more than double the total of FY2018)
- 2 instances of a non-Alaskan suspect being identified in an unsolved Alaska case.
- 22 instances of an Alaskan offender being identified as a suspect in a case from another state (more than double the total of FY2018).

A total of 124 cases were searched against the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) resulting in 76 fingerprint hits.

Training in forensic recovery and evidence handling was provided to multiple law enforcement agencies throughout the state in FY2019. Trainings included two Alaska Law Enforcement Training Academies (ALET) in Sitka, a lateral hire Department of Public Safety Academy, and two three-day trainings with Ketchikan PD and Valdez PD. The Alaska Scientific Crime Detection Laboratory also provided two breath test supervisor schools and trainings in sexual assault recovery. The Alaska Scientific Crime Detection Laboratory also provided training to attorneys in the Department of Law.

#### **Key Component Challenges**

Recruitment for experienced analysts continues to be an ongoing challenge and has resulted in recruitment at the entry level. Hiring at this level results in extended training periods for both the analyst in training and experienced analysts who are taken away from casework to provide the training. Each position recruited at entry level results in approximately a 1.5 position loss of productivity.

### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

Changes in work flow in the Forensic Biology discipline continue, with the goal of achieving a 60-day total turnaround time for sexual assault cases.

Previously untested sexual assault kits will be outsourced for analysis, and subsequent eligible forensic profiles reviewed and entered into Combined DNA Index System (CODIS). This project is estimated to be completed in late 2021.

With the increase in submissions and the goal of achieving a 60-day total turnaround time for sexual assault cases, the forensic biology discipline is adapting their approach to sexual assault kit processing using a shorter training program for new analysts and a quicker turnaround time for non-interpretive (negative) cases.

A new Laboratory Information Management System will be implemented in FY2020. While this may cause some initial downtime and increases in average turnaround, ASCDL expects to see efficiencies in all areas from evidence handling to analysis and report generation within 3 months of implementation.

Changes in leadership within the Department of Public Safety and the Alaska Scientific Crime Detection Laboratory mean that the ASCDL will be providing an increased crime scene response presence. There has been a 25% increase in crime scene response requests so far in FY2020.

In the first quarter of FY2020 ASCDL has seen submissions increase dramatically in most disciplines within the lab (Forensic Alcohol 24%, Seized Drug 39%, Forensic Biology 50%, DNA Database 51%, Firearm/Toolmark 16%, Crime Scenes 25%). If this trend continues throughout the year, maintaining current turnaround times may not be possible.

The ASCDL intends to extend the scope of training provided to include all parties within the Alaska criminal justice system.

Add the appropriation made in Sec7 Ch3 FSSLA2019 P19 L22 (SB19) related to House Bill 49 (HB49) Crimes; Sentencing; Drugs; Theft; Reports Ch4 FSSLA2019.

HB49 amends AS 44.41 by adding a new section that requires law enforcement agencies to submit to the state crime lab for testing all sexual assault kits collected by the agency within 30 days after collection; requires the state crime lab to test all eligible sexual assault kits within one year of a sexual assault kit being received by the crime lab; and requires that reasonable attempts be made to notify victims within two weeks after completion of the testing that their sexual assault kit has been tested.

Two additional Forensic Scientist III positions will be needed to address the increase in caseload and meet the required turnaround time for processing. Funding is also needed for necessary consumables (chemicals for testing) associated with additional processing volume.

Total first year costs are estimated at \$342,512 which includes nine months of personal services costs for two new Forensic Scientist III positions, the cost for consumables for training the new staff, and a six-month outsource contract to maintain turnaround times while the new staff are trained. Second and subsequent year costs are estimated at \$278,824 for continued funding of two positions and annual costs for necessary consumables.

This bill amends AS 44.41 by adding a new section that requires law enforcement agencies to submit to the state crime lab for testing all sexual assault kits collected by the agency within 30 days after collection; requires the state crime lab to test all eligible sexual assault kits within one year of a sexual assault kit being received by the crime lab; and requires that reasonable attempts be made to notify victims within two weeks after completion of the testing that their sexual assault kit has been tested.

Presently, not every sexual assault kit collected by law enforcement is submitted to the crime lab for scientific analysis. Approximately 120 kits fall into this category annually. This fiscal note assumes that once received by the crime lab, all sexual assault kits will be tested except those defined as ineligible under the bill.

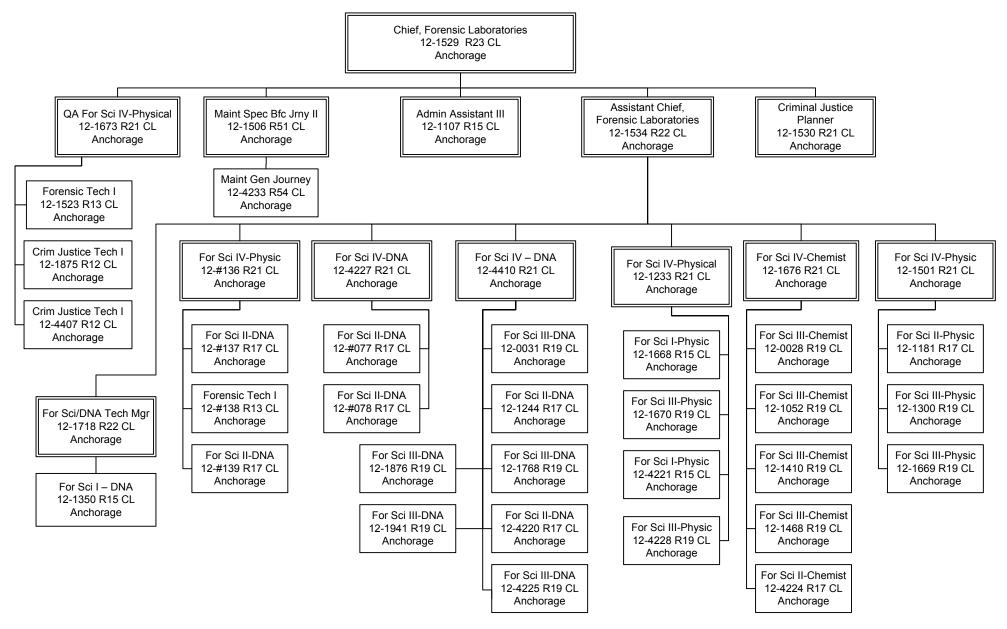
