Contribution to Department's Mission

Preserve public peace, protect life, property, and resources.

Core Services

- Transport prisoners throughout Alaska: between institutions; between institutions and courthouses; to and from doctor's appointments; and extradite wanted persons back to Alaska.
- Provide timely service of legal process including subpoenas, summons and complaints, writs of assistance, evictions, executions of various types, child custody orders, mental health commitments, and domestic violence protective orders.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2019

Judicial Services units are located in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Bethel, Anchor Point, Juneau, Kenai, Ketchikan, Nome, and Palmer. During FY2019, the following accomplishments occurred statewide in all of the judicial services offices.

Key Component Challenges

With the continued implementation of the Alaska Report Management System (ARMS) throughout the state, the various Judicial Services (JS) units are coping with the implementation of new procedures to standardize the collection and recording of JS statistics.

FY2019 has shown an increase in the number of prisoner transports. In general, there has been a decrease in the number of in-custody jury trials, as a result of lowered bail schedules. However, there have been more cases plead out, as a result there are more cases being heard, and more prisoners necessitating transport to and from court. In Anchorage, pro tem (retired judges), and civil trial judges are occasionally being used to alleviate the criminal caseload, which increases the number of concurrent jury trials. Court security response times are anticipated to grow and the numbers of court processes issued are expected to increase.

The Boney Courthouse has a significant sized prisoner holding area that was included in the remodel, unfortunately JS does not have the manpower to adequately staff it for its intended use at this time. Adequate staffing for would eliminate the need to transport inmates from one courthouse to the other on a regular basis.

The screening points at the courthouses with contracted security provide for public screening for approximately 61,000 people a month between the seven courthouses. These screenings have discovered roughly 800 prohibited items a month, many of which have required an officer response.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

Anchorage Judicial Services (JS) has initiated a process of working with the courts to ensure that defendants with multiple cases in more than one jurisdiction are only transported when essential. If a defendant has multiple open felony cases in Kenai, and a single Anchorage misdemeanor, Anchorage JS will attempt to ensure that the defendant remains in Kenai to complete the felony cases, provided this arrangement will not conflict with statutory or court rule appearance requirements.

Initial statistics from FY2019 indicate that there will likely be an increase of 5-7% in prisoner transports, in keeping with the general trend from previous years. The division moved 85,226 prisoners in FY2018, and 95,920 prisoners in FY2019. The Department's goal to prevent escapes and assaults on inmates by other inmates continues to be a security priority.

Add authority to increase staffing and operational capacity to an adequate level to address demands for statewide law enforcement services.

The Alaska crime rate continues to increase with many locations having little to no law enforcement staff or support requiring Troopers to respond to calls in that area. Current staffing levels create delays when responding to calls regarding domestic violence, sexual assaults, drug related crimes, murder, and various other reported crimes. The US Attorney has declared a law enforcement emergency in rural Alaska due to insufficient or lack of law enforcement staffing and support. This increase in authority will assist with these issues and bring operational capacity to more appropriate staffing levels based on statewide needs and allow the ability to respond to calls in a more appropriate timeframe. The AST recruitment unit is receiving great support and has, for the last two academies, demonstrated an ability to secure recruits of commissioned officers at a higher rate with fewer employees leaving now results in a need for additional positions.
