## **Component: Statewide Procurement**

### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Provide professional and effective procurement administration.

### **Core Services**

- Manage the department's procurement delegations.
- Establish, update, and enforce department wide procurement policies and procedures.
- Provide consultation and guidance to the department's regional procurement offices.
- Establish and manage marine vessel maintenance overhaul and repair contracts for the Alaska Marine Highway System (AMHS).
- Establish term contracts and spot market purchases for high use supplies, commodities, and materials needed on a statewide basis.
- Establish professional services contracts, service contracts, term contracts, lease/leasing agreements, and facility use agreements, department-wide.
- Manage the department property control program.
- Provide warehouse services including maintaining and managing inventory stock, receiving, distributing, and logistics for Southcoast maintenance and operations, headquarters, and AMHS.

## **Major Component Accomplishments in 2019**

- Provided contract administration/management for approximately 367 contracts and agreements.
- Processed 8,494 Purchase Orders (PO) valued at \$63,928.2 through the Integrated Resources Information System (IRIS).
- Awarded approximately 173 contracts and agreements.
- Successful merge of Central Region Procurement with Statewide Contracting and Procurement, effective July 1, 2018.
- Warehouse inventories accomplished inside IRIS for the Central and Southcoast Regions.
- Released \$2,151.6 of funds from 427 POs in a statewide cleanup effort.
- Completed a full review, analysis, and streamlined the procurement document workflow in IRIS to ensure
  workflow rules were pertinent, efficient, and accurate. This project reviewed the workflow rules for 375 distinct
  units and all IRIS procurement documents.

## **Key Component Challenges**

- Assisting Division of Facilities Services (DFS) with establishing contracting and procurement activities, delegations and OneCard transaction limits. Continue having warehouse discussions to assist DFS in storing needed supplies and equipment.
- Continue to increase employee proficiency and ability to function efficiently in the statewide accounting and procurement system, IRIS.
- Continuing to develop procurement and warehouse reports in the Alaska Data Enterprise Reporting (ALDER) system.
- Updating policies and procedures pertaining to procurement and property functions.

## Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

Continuing to learn and use the finance, procurement, and human resource management modules in IRIS and ALDER for reporting requirements.
