Component: Anchorage Airport Administration

Contribution to Department's Mission

Provide the overall airport management and leadership necessary to ensure that all airport functions are conducted in accordance with appropriate laws, regulations, policies, and procedures and in a safe, efficient, and cost-effective manner.

Core Services

- Plan, organize, direct and control airport functions.
- Administer a business development program.
- Develop and facilitate cargo and passenger facility expansions, terminal development and strategic business planning.
- Maintain a positive public communications program.
- Provide engineering oversight/coordination of construction activities and manage the Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport (ANC) Master Plan.
- Develop and implement environmental policies and plans to meet legal requirements.
- Process, negotiate, and manage ANC real estate leases, airline and terminal space leases, concession
 agreements, and other third-party agreements and encourage and promote new and expanded airline service
 and concession opportunities for the benefit of the traveling public and other airport users.
- Provide and manage network infrastructure and system security of all information systems for all functions of the airport.
- Improve communication and business continuity between airport and existing businesses.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2019

- Negotiated Fly Fur gallery with David Green Group in Concourse C.
- Developed Baby Vend kiosk in the C Concourse.
- Added Humpy's Ale House to Concourse C, replacing Pork and Pickle.
- Completed reconstruction and widening of Runway 15/33 and managed noise complaints related to the rerouting
 of air traffic during reconstruction
- · Reconstructed Taxiway F.
- Negotiated a new Stormwater Discharge Permit with Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation.
- Sold three buildings at Kulis Business Park: Lynden purchased Buildings 37 and Hangar 46 for \$5,500.0. J&M Properties (Naniq) purchased Building 50 for \$750.0. New land leases generate approximately \$320.0 in additional annual rent.
- Received three applications for air cargo development: Block 34 (Bog) AK Cargo and Cold Storage to develop
 approximately 26 acres and invest approximately \$200,000.0; FedEx to develop approximately 24 acres and
 invest approximately \$57,000.0; Block 27 (north of Alaska CargoPort) 6A Aviation to develop approximately 28
 acres and invest approximately \$170,000.0.
- Met with more than 30 current and/or new airlines (cargo and passenger) to discuss new routes and service to or through Anchorage.
- New carrier, Allegiant Airlines, began summer seasonal service from Bellingham, Washington to Anchorage in May 2019.

Key Component Challenges

- Maximizing the use of Kulis Business Park in order to generate revenues. Specific redevelopment challenges are park-wide utility upgrades and building code compliance requirements.
- Increasing employee proficiency and their ability to function efficiently while fully leveraging the statewide accounting and procurement system, Integrated Resource Information System.
- Getting approval to add a staff position to deliver vertical construction and facility related capital projects.
- Working with regulators and developers to ensure new environmental regulations covering per- and poly-

fluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) do not interfere with operations and development on airport.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

No significant changes are anticipated.
