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Component: Anchorage Airport Safety

Contribution to Department's Mission

Airport Police and Fire (AP&F) provides Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF), law enforcement, emergency medical technician, radio dispatch communications, hazardous materials response, structural firefighting, rescue response, and other safety-related services necessary to meet Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) airport certification and Transportation Security Administration (TSA) security requirements and emergency response needs of airport tenants and the traveling public on a 24-hour, 365 days per year basis.

Core Services

- Provide crash/fire rescue and emergency medical services for Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport (ANC) in compliance with FAA mandates as well as other federal, state, and local requirements.
- Plan, staff, train for, and respond to real and simulated aircraft, structure, terroristic threats and incidents, accidents, medical emergencies, and natural disasters.
- Provide 24-hour law enforcement and security.
- Provide 24-hour central dispatch radio and telephone communications for all airport functions and emergencies.
- Provide oversight of passenger screening activities.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2019

- Airport Police K-9, "Skye", continues to be an asset to the department and the State of Alaska, making continuous major impacts on narcotics trafficking.
- Assigned department Task Force Officer to participate in Statewide Drug Enforcement Unit assigned to ANC.
- Continued water rescue team training. No longer solely reliant on commercial contract to fulfill FAA response requirements in surrounding bodies of water.
- Participation in nationwide Human Trafficking initiatives and training.
- Increased Active Shooter training and education to airport employees, tenants, and community members.
- Scheduled for initial assessment towards international department accreditation with Commission on Accreditation of Law Enforcement Agencies.

Key Component Challenges

- Staffing and officer recruitment and retention to maintain FAA and TSA federally mandated ARFF, law enforcement and security standards. Department continues to work at minimum staffing levels. Consistently operating at 20-30% vacancy rate. Critical need for compensation parity with other public safety departments throughout the state.
- High annual attrition rates combined with difficult recruiting environment is detrimental to effective emergency operations, training, staffing, budgets, and morale.
- The liquid hydrocarbon fuel fire pit is closed without an alternative way of meeting federal ARFF training requirements. If left unaddressed, the airport is in jeopardy of not being able to meet FAA mandated minimum ARFF training standards. Without an on-site fire trainer, the entire department may require out-of-state travel to meet requirements.
- Aging equipment fleet needs replacing. There has not been a replacement for expired 1500-gallon apparatus, and newest apparatus are over 12 years old. Continuing to manage older water tenders that were acquired in 1989.
- The AP&F facility needs replacement. The current building is in constant degradation, and design standards have never met the operational demands for a public safety facility.
- Beach access road to water access is constantly being washed out by tides, requiring frequent repairs to ensure water rescue equipment has ready access to water in compliance with FAA requirements.
- Need improvements to current facilities to accommodate increased demand for police and fire training provided for other state and municipal departments, and state and rural airports.
- Responding to changing TSA mandates and priorities that are not consistent with local and regional security

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concerns.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

• Enhanced multi-agency narcotics interdiction.
