## **Department of Labor and Workforce Development Workers' Compensation Benefits Guaranty Fund Component Budget Summary**

**Component: Workers' Compensation Benefits Guaranty Fund**

**Contribution to Department's Mission**

Paying benefits to workers who have been injured while working for an employer that was not in compliance with the Workers' Compensation Act and fails to pay benefits owed to the injured worker.

**Core Services**

- Provide workers' compensation benefits to injured employees of uninsured employers.
- Collect penalties from uninsured employers.
- Seek reimbursement of benefit payments from uninsured employers.

**Major Component Accomplishments in 2020**

During FY2020, the Workers' Compensation Benefits Guaranty Fund collected \$661,100 in revenue.

**Key Component Challenges**

A key challenge facing the Workers' Compensation Benefits Guaranty Fund (WCBGF) component is a significant potential liability of \$4.4 million against the fund from 44 open/pending claims – exceeding the current fund balance of approximately \$3.7 million. The actual liability to the fund is likely much lower than \$4.4 million as the potential liability of each claim is usually reduced through the adjudication process or by finding the WCBGF not liable.

**Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2022**

No significant changes in results to be delivered are anticipated.
