Subject: **Monetary terms of the 7/1/21 through 6/30/22 collective bargaining agreement between the State of Alaska and the Organization of Masters, Mates & Pilots**

The Administration has concluded bargaining the successor collective bargaining agreement with the International Organization of Masters Mates & Pilots, representing the Alaska Marine Highway System Licensed Deck Officers. The tentative agreement is effective July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. This below report of monetary terms is consistent with the requirements of the Public Employment Relations Act. Please forward these monetary terms to the Legislature in accordance with AS 23.40.215.

I. Terms Requiring Appropriation.

Current Legislative Session

- A 3% raise effective prospectively upon legislative approval
- Upon legislative approval, a lump sum payment for back wages if approval is delayed beyond July 1, 2021
- Effective prospectively upon legislative approval, an increase in employer contributions to monthly health insurance premiums to \$1,555 per eligible member per month

Future Legislative Sessions

Not applicable as the agreement will expire June 30, 2022.

II. Change in State Revenues.

No term of this agreement would result in a change to State revenues.

III. Change in Productive Work Hours.

No term of this agreement would result in a change to productive work hours.

IV. Terms addressing employee compensation, not requiring appropriation.

No other terms substantially change employee compensation
