## **Component: International Airport Systems Office**

### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Provide relevant and reliable financial information to the Alaska International Airports System (AIAS) and its stakeholders.

### **Core Services**

- Establish uniform rates and charges for air carriers, concessionaires, and others using the AIAS, which consists
  of the Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport and Fairbanks International Airport. Perform ongoing
  evaluation of those rates and charges to ensure financial goals are achieved.
- Provide for timely and informative financial reporting for use by state, Federal Aviation Administration, airport management, air carriers, rating agencies, bondholders, and other stakeholders.
- Ensure effective and appropriate accounting and financial internal controls, policies and procedures are in place.
- Evaluate the fiscal impact of airport development and administration plans such as terminal and field expansion, parking garages, land lease rates, and aircraft tie-down fees. Develop fiscal constraints to be followed by management.
- Identify auditing needs and arrange for and oversee the annual enterprise fund external financial audit.
- Assist in the ongoing implementation of the AIAS passenger Terminal Lease and Operating Agreement.
- Monitor AIAS capital project funding needs, ensuring that appropriate financing methodologies are employed, and alternatives are reviewed and considered as market conditions and funding requirements warrant.
- Coordinate with the Department of Revenue on AIAS revenue bond issues and ensure timely fulfillment of ongoing disclosure requirements.

### **Major Component Accomplishments in 2020**

- Maintained level rates and fees structure while meeting unprecedented shifts in passenger and cargo airline traffic volume, with a dramatic decline in concession activity/revenues at both Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport (ANC) and Fairbanks International Airport.
- Applied for and received substantive fiscal relief from adverse pandemic impact on passenger volumes through participation in Federal Aviation Administration CARES Act grant funding available to airports.
- Have undertaken potential general airport revenue bond refunding effort intended for economic savings designed to front-load benefit to pandemic impacted fiscal periods to the extent possible under current market conditions.

## **Key Component Challenges**

- Maintaining continued customer confidence in AIAS through stability of rates and use-terms and dissemination of useful and timely financial information.
- Projecting activity levels to develop accurate revenue budgets and managing expenses proficiently helps produce stable and reliable rate and fee levels, which in turn helps provide airline customers, especially international cargo carriers, with confidence needed to support current and planned operations.
- Continuing efforts to increase employee proficiency and their ability to function efficiently while more fully leveraging information collection and reporting efforts.

### **COVID-19 Response and Telework Challenges**

• While experiencing some degradation of operational efficiencies resulting from need to meet pandemic related challenges, no insurmountable challenges so far.

### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2022

No materially significant changes anticipated, dependent upon long-term impact of pandemic on passenger and cargo airlines market activities; will continue ongoing efforts at optimizing efficiency and productivity through continuous
