Department of Transportation/Public Facilities Fairbanks Airport Facilities Component Budget Summary

Component: Fairbanks Airport Facilities

Contribution to Department's Mission

Protect the state's investment in the Fairbanks International Airport's (FAI) buildings by maintaining, in the most cost-effective manner possible, infrastructure, utilities, structures, non-State of Alaska (SOA) networks and other facilities to meet their expected life cycle at an acceptable level of service, and to present at all times a clean and attractive passenger terminal and other airport facilities to the traveling public, airport tenants, and employees.

Core Services

- Operate and maintain the airport terminal buildings, field maintenance facilities, aircraft rescue and firefighting facility, and all other facilities at the Fairbanks International Airport.
- Operate and maintain heating, ventilation and air conditioning climate systems, baggage conveyor systems, escalators and elevators, automated doors and gates, interior lighting systems, surface finishing, exterior electrical systems including runway and taxiway lights, aircraft tie-downs, vehicle parking, electrical outlets, and floodlights.
- Operate and maintain all non-SOA information technology (IT) and operational technology (OT) networks and monitor cyber security of OT networks. OT networks include airfield lighting controls, close circuit television (CCTV), access control security, HVAC, and baggage handling and screening.
- Coordinate both tenant and state sponsored construction, renovations, repairs, and small projects.
- Landscaping around the passenger terminal, public parking and air park campground; provide multiple daily cleaning cycles in the passenger terminal, other airport buildings, the air park campground, and private pilots lounge.
- Ice remediation and removing snow from sidewalks and walkways during the winter.
- Maintain artwork and tend flower gardens.
- Ensure cleanliness and sanitization of the terminal to prevent the spread of communicable diseases.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2020

- Integrated State IT for all non-SOA airport networks (IT & OT).
- Overhauled the baggage handling system (BHS) make up unit.
- Updated security on all OT networks.
- Completed airfield sign replacement project.
- Replaced in-pavement guard lights on Runway 2L/20R with LED fixtures.
- Implemented police body camera system with Watch Guard Security.
- Upgraded more than 200 light fixtures in terminal to LEDs.
- Remodeled the pilots' lounge for general aviation users.
- Completed security upgrade project, adding 294 new CCTV cameras and 20 new access control points.
- Implemented Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and SOA's COVID-19 advanced cleaning and sanitization protocols in all FAI facilities.
- Oiling of the terminal wooden floor.

Key Component Challenges

- Recruiting and retaining qualified employees.
- Procuring information technology systems equipment for the airport's network (non-state network), maintained by component staff.
- Cost increases for consumable supplies and parts.
- Procuring parts for older systems; life cycles on systems/equipment are shorter, requiring replacement of systems.

COVID-19 Response and Telework Challenges

- With 24/7 operations and limited staff, it is difficult to manage leave requests that includes travel out of Alaska that required out-of-state travel quarantine requirements.
- Working as a team on projects that require multiple employees, while maintaining social distancing.
- Working to implement advanced cleaning protocols have increased the workload for all terminal services staff.
- Nationwide shortages of cleaning and personal protective equipment supplies.
- Telework is not an option for this component.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2022

- Installation of new escalators in terminal building.
