Project Description/Justification:

This appropriation helps reduce deferred maintenance projects in DMVA's inventory, extend the useful life of assets, and improve energy efficiency of facilities. Projects also bring federal modernization and sustainment dollars into Alaska from the National Guard Bureau.

DMVA prioritizes life, safety, code compliance, and federal funding priorities. Federal funding levels fluctuate based on specific projects, federal priorities, and budget cycles. Funding ratios are based on the facility's classification, use, and regulations. Priorities and cost estimates may need to be changed to accommodate emergency maintenance projects not listed, actual project costs, and other considerations.

Construct Women's Shower and Bathroom at Armories Around the State: The Kodiak, Ketchikan, and Sitka armories have no women's bathroom or shower facility, making them out of compliance with both State and federal law. Creating a bathroom for female service members and armory users will increase longevity of the armories and ensure its continued relevance.

Civil Support Team (CST) Mezzanine and Classroom: Create a mezzanine and classroom in the CST building to meet readiness objectives and requirements.

Replace Ketchikan Armory Roof: Ketchikan armory roof has far exceeded its reasonable life expectancy. It is actively leaking and needs to be replaced.

Replace Organization and Maintenance Shop (OMS) Roof JBER: OMS roof has exceeded its life span by 12 years. It is actively leaking and needs to be replaced.

Remodel Former Criminal Investigation Divisions (CID) Building: Remodel and bring up to code the former CID building located on Bryant Army Airfield to be used as flight airfield operations building. Replace new fire alarm panel and mass notification system.
