


Contribution to Department's Mission







Major Component Accomplishments in 2021

Early in 2021, the division implemented the Public and Individual Assistance programs in response to a significant storm event that occurred in southeast Alaska, including a fatal landslide in Haines. The Division also responded to a fire in the community of Tuluksak that destroyed the community washeteria and water treatment plant. In the spring the community of Buckland within the Northwest Arctic Borough experienced record flooding, and the division continues to provide disaster assistance to the community, individuals, and families.

Due to the ongoing response and mitigation activities to the COVID-19 pandemic, DHS&EM continued to support exercise, training, and outreach events, mostly in a virtual fashion. DHS&EM provided instructional training to over 1,000 individuals from state, local and tribal entities during 62 specialized training events, with the vast majority of these events being web-based. The outreach section participated in 64 events, reaching approximately 7,600 Alaskans. As in 2020, local communities continued to be focused on responding to the pandemic, but the Division was able to support 20 communities through seven exercises.

DHS&EM continued to manage 11 federal and 11 state disasters in 2021, providing \$52.9 million in assistance to individuals, families, and communities. One new federal disaster and two new state disasters occurred in 2021. In addition to the declared disasters the division is managing, the State Emergency Operations Center responded to 65 incidents or events through November 1, 2021

In the area of planning, the division supported the completion of 50 Emergency Operations Plans, 93 Small Community Emergency Response Plans (SCERP), and 94 Local Hazard Mitigation Plans (LHMP). An additional 25 SCERPs and 30 LHMPs are under development. The division successfully managed four key federal grants that support preparedness and resilience activities throughout the state.

Key Component Challenges

The COVID-19 Pandemic continues to task local and state emergency management capabilities. While the Division has risen to the occasion and continued to deliver services in a mostly virtual fashion, the reduction of direct-in-person communication with local communities, tribal organizations, and agency partners will require the agency to focus on a "back-to-the-basics" approach and reengage partnerships at all levels of government and the private sector. DHS&EM and the SEOC continue to respond to requests for State assistance (monetary and technical) for events that fall outside of the scope of Alaska Statute 26.23.900. Events such as erosion, fuel shortages, and water shortages continue to challenge communities throughout Alaska. The SFY22 budget, with support from the Legislature, continued to see a significant influx of funding into the Disaster Relief Fund (DRF). Maintaining this legislatively-approved, readily available fund source is key to the State's ability to speed relief and recovery actions during various emergency scenarios.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2023

Component — Homeland Security and Emergency Management

FY2023 operations in the COVID-19 environment will continue to rely heavily on technology for virtual communications that is often not as available or effective for Alaska's rural communities. As the pandemic environment wanes, the Division will place increased focus on in-person service delivery, particularly to communities and individuals off the road system.
