The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act provides hundreds of millions in federal funds that will be awarded to Alaska for water and wastewater projects. In order to implement these programs, the department will require increased capacity in the Clean Water, Drinking Water, Village Safe Water, and Technical Assistance & Financing programs. Federal funding will be available in these grant programs starting in FY2023 to support department operations.

Funding and staffing estimates are based on anticipated capital appropriations for Village Safe Water and set-asides from supplemental capitalization grants to the Alaska Clean Water and Alaska Drinking Water State Revolving Loan Funds over the next five years, as well as preliminary guidance received on how the funds will be able to be used. As more information is received, the department anticipates adjustments to the staffing and line items necessary for implementation in order to maintain sufficient capacity over the next five years to support the increased infrastructure investment occurring in the state.

The Division of Administration needs additional staff resources to support the Village Safe Water procurement team, as well as the facilities accounting team which provides accounting services directly to Village Safe Water and the Revolving Loan Fund programs.
