**Project Description/Justification:**

Provide miscellaneous airfield and landside improvements. Typical projects result from winter conditions, facility, and equipment failures, and changed operating requirements by the airlines, security requirements, and Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) airport certification. Resolve minor deficiencies and solve problems created by unforeseen circumstances for both the airport and leaseholders.

The airport needs to react quickly to make needed repairs and improvements outside the detailed Projects Program. The projects are often needed to meet changed conditions created by airline operations or FAA requirements. This relatively small dollar project has been funded on a yearly basis.
