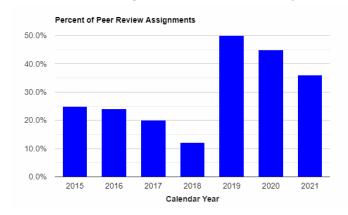

Major Component Accomplishments in 2022

- Continued to offer high quality mediation services across case types.
- Opened more than 1,800 new cases across more than sixty different areas of law.
- Resolved, through decision, mediation, or dismissal, more than 2,000 matters.
- Heard and issued full decisions in more than 950 cases across more than 35 areas of law.
- Continued to assist Department of Labor and Workforce Development (DOLWD) in addressing its backlog of pandemic-related appeals. Through cooperation with DOLWD, OAH issued decisions in more than 800 Pandemic Unemployment Assistance and Unemployment Insurance appeals during the fiscal year.
- Continued to mediate more than 90% of referred Medicaid Services cases, with more than 85% of those cases resolving because of mediation.
- Continued working with state agencies to increase the percentage of administrative hearings and appeals being voluntarily referred to OAH.
- Continued marketing OAH's lower cost mediation and adjudication services to municipalities, school districts, and state-related entities.
- Continued using videoconferencing technology to allow for face-to-face hearings and mediations for participants unable to attend in-person proceedings.
- Provided multiple sessions of in-house training which meets continuing legal education needs to OAH Administrative Law Judges (ALJs).

Key Component Challenges

Adjudication Services – Challenges include: (1) with half of OAH ALJs at or near retirement age, the difficulty recruiting high quality ALJ candidates at the current ALJ salary scale; (2) the logistics of conducting remote hearings telephonically and by video since the pandemic; and (3) serial staff vacancies and recruitment difficulties.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2024

Adjudication Services – Update hearing room technology to enable video-conferenced and hybrid hearings (i.e., hearings where some participants are attending in person and others are attending remotely). Continue expanding administrative adjudication and mediation services to encompass additional case categories, including continuing to encourage municipalities and school districts to use OAH's lower-cost services, as permitted by statute.

Mediation - Continue expanding the use of mediation to resolve appeals referred to OAH.

Services – Bring in new revenues by providing additional or expanded services to municipalities, school districts, and state related entities.

Training and Monitoring – Expand training opportunities for administrative adjudicators and monitor the adjudication

and mediation processes.

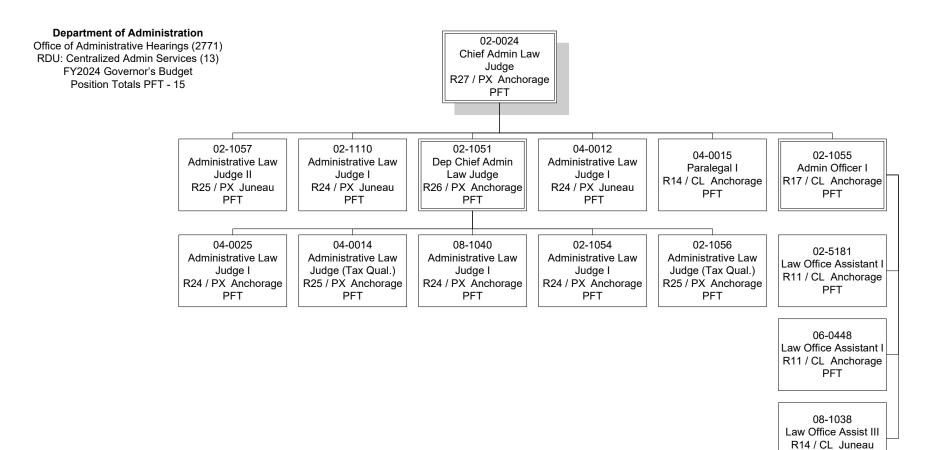
