Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

This project will provide safe, easy access shelter above the inundation zone, in case of a major tsunami event, for the residents of the Native Village of Ouzinkie. The project also provides for consolidation of all emergency response heavy equipment machinery into one secure, weatherproof location. The village's equipment is currently staged throughout the community and is exposed to the elements. This project facilitates local response and capacity in the event of a major tsunami event, reducing the need for outside resources and assistance, that could then be directed elsewhere to support other communities in distress.
