Department of Education and Early Development Library Operations Component Budget Summary

Component: Library Operations

Contribution to Department's Mission

By providing access to information, to train school and public librarians, and by preserving the history of the state, Alaskans have access to information and resources to support lifelong learning.

Core Services

- HISTORICAL COLLECTIONS: Provides reference and research services on Alaskana subjects. It collects, organizes, preserves, and provides access to Alaskan materials including private papers and materials important to the state's culture and history.
- INFORMATION SERVICES: Concentrates on access to up-to-date information for state agencies and the legislature by providing periodicals, reports, state and federal documents, and other materials in a variety of formats. Municipal governments, the private sector, Native organizations, schools, and the general public also rely on these services. Operates the State Documents Depository, collecting and distributing materials published by state agencies, regardless of format.
- LIBRARY DEVELOPMENT: Staff provides assistance and information to all libraries and library staff regarding library management, operations and technology, E-Rate, the OWL program, early childhood literacy, grants available from the State Library, library statistics, federal programs, and continuing education statewide. Coordinates the books by mail service for Alaskans and partners with the Alaska Library Network on the statewide databases.
- TALKING BOOKS CENTER: The service was successfully outsourced to the Utah State Library in 2016. The Alaska State Library receives and reviews patron applications, then transfers the applications to Utah for service, and publicizes the program statewide.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2022

Historical Collections and Information Services

- Preservica has been implemented as a digital repository, providing long-term preservation and access of digital assets. Information Services continues to add State of Alaska agency content regularly and has started adding a limited quantity of federal and privately produced content related to Alaska. The Historical Collections implemented storage and preservation of born digital or digitized files which are primarily from our photo and manuscripts collections. Over a terabyte has been added so far and we're currently working on best options for uploading very large video files;
- Continued participation in the Alaska Library Catalog, which provides patrons with direct access to 2.9 million titles held by 88 Alaska libraries that serve 92 percent of the state's population. Checkouts of tangible materials have rebounded since the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, from three million in 2019, down to 1.9 million in 2021, and back up to 2.8 million in 2022. Meanwhile, checkouts of e-books, and downloadable audiobooks and magazines through the Alaska Digital Library have continued to increase, albeit not as drastically as during the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, from 524,000 in 2019, to 712,000 in 2021, to 751,903 in 2022;
- The Historical Collections staff continue with the implementation of ArchivesSpace to provide intellectual access to manuscript, photograph, and audiovisual collections. Approximately 125 records were added or amended, of which 29 were new records completed for access. This is an on-going project.
- Library staff continues to add to the Alaskan content available online. Alaskan images and some text have been made available through Alaska's Digital Archives, with nearly 500 digitized items added for public access in 2022;
- Staff continues to make sure new content posted by the State Library meets accessibility standards;
- Accessioned 20 donations, a decline from previous years, including slides, postcards, photographic prints, scrapbooks, books, salmon can labels, historical newspapers, films, and more;
- Maintained the statewide subscriptions for Teen Health and Wellness and TumbleBooks, through the Statewide Library Electronic Doorway (<u>https://sled.alaska.edu/</u>); and
- Increased number of on-site visitor numbers over twice the number in 2022 (2,509 in the Reading Room) than
 in 2021 (about 1,070 in the Reading Room). This was especially notable during the summer, when the number of
 out-of-town visitors seemed even higher than before the COVID-19 pandemic.

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Library Development

- Distributed Public Library Assistance grants of \$7,000 each to 87 library outlets, totaling \$608,969;
- Distributed four statewide grants totaling \$526,604, which provided audiobooks to blind Alaskans, library services by mail and phone to rural Alaskans, and supported the Alaska Library Network, which provides a wide variety of services to libraries statewide;
- Awarded \$510,441 to the Alaska Library Network to support the purchase of statewide online resources on the Statewide Library Electronic Doorway (SLED);
- Supported the statewide Battle of the Books reading competition, the Summer Reading Program, and a variety of reading enhancement grants to libraries, including StoryWalks and local big reads projects;
- Received \$2.1 million in federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to provide grants for Alaska's libraries, archives, and museums. Over 100 libraries, archives, and museums received \$580,229 in ARPA funds to purchase COVID-19 pandemic relief materials to and to buy books for their collections. A total of 58 libraries, archives, and museums received \$1.5 million in ARPA funds for larger projects, such as projects to enhance digital services, to buy digital content for users statewide, and to offer enhanced services for users following the pandemic;
- Continued funding for schools and libraries universal service support program, commonly known as the E-rate program. The E-Rate program consultant helped schools and libraries to obtain affordable broadband by working with every school district and most public libraries on the E-Rate application process. The program has helped secure more than \$142 million in funding to Alaska's schools and libraries;
- The E-Rate consultant and the Head of Library Development have been working closely with tribal libraries that are forming so that they can apply for E-Rate funding. The Federal Communications Commission expanded their program for tribal libraries to access this funding in January 2022; and
- Worked with consultants and the Governor's Advisory Council on Libraries to successfully compile the legally-required Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) Five Year Evaluation and the subsequent LSTA Five Year State Plan. These two documents review how we have used Library Services and Technology funds from the Institute of Museum Services over the past five years and how we will use the funds over the next five years.

Key Component Challenges

- The shift from physical access to virtual access for Alaskana materials means that staff must segment their handling of these materials, re-tool traditional processes, and obtain staff training to meet the new demands of the virtual world. Digital collections also demand storage solutions and software to provide for access and preservation;
- Since both Information Services and the Historical Collections obtain materials in a wide variety of formats, the Division faces several challenges in preserving and providing access to these items. For newer formats, staff continue to work on developing better systems for finding, accessing, and preserving electronic resources. The on-going and increasing cost of digital data storage remains an unsolved challenge;
- The Division has reached a critical stage with some audiovisual material that cannot currently be accessed due to the lack of working equipment, a problem that will expand over time as more audio-visual equipment becomes obsolete, unavailable, or irreparable; and
- Due to transfers, retirements, resignations, and failed recruitments, the Library Development unit has been reduced from six filled positions to just one. The Division Director revised job descriptions to increase recruitment efforts before her retirement in October 2022. 2023 will be a year of rebuilding and training new staff.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2024

After a year-long trial of Preservica, a cloud-based digital preservation platform, the State Library determined it could meet the State's digital preservation needs and expanded usage, with over a terabyte of new content added in 2022. State Libraries will continue to work closely with Preservica to address issues and to move preservation copies from our legacy servers.

On March 11, 2021, the federal American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021 (H.R. 1319) was signed into law. This act includes an allocation of \$2.2 million to the State of Alaska from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS). The IMLS will provide funding to the State Library Administrative Agency, the Division of Libraries, Archives, and Museums (LAM), to award grants that support the vital programs and services that have been impacted by the COVID-19 health emergency. IMLS provided the following priorities for spending:

a. First, to enable libraries to reach residents with internet hotspots, accessible Wi-Fi, and other digital inclusion efforts, particularly in support of education, health, and workforce development needs. The following types of data, among others, can inform efforts to reach underserved populations:

- Poverty/Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP);
- Unemployment;

Broadband availability;

b. Second, to provide rapid emergency relief to libraries across the country, allowing them to safely respond to the pandemic and implement public health protocols;

c. Third, to support library services that meet the needs of communities throughout the U.S., including costs such as personnel, technology, training, materials, supplies, equipment, and associated indirect costs; and

d. With respect to (a), (b), or (c), reach tribal and museum partners best positioned to assist with pandemic response efforts, in addition to traditionally eligible library entities, where appropriate.

Funding is available until September 30, 2022. There is no match requirement for these funds and no Maintenance of Effort provision. Funding will be awarded to local libraries, archives, and museums throughout the state based on a competitive grant application process. The Division of Libraries, Archives and Museums may use up to four percent for administrative oversight.

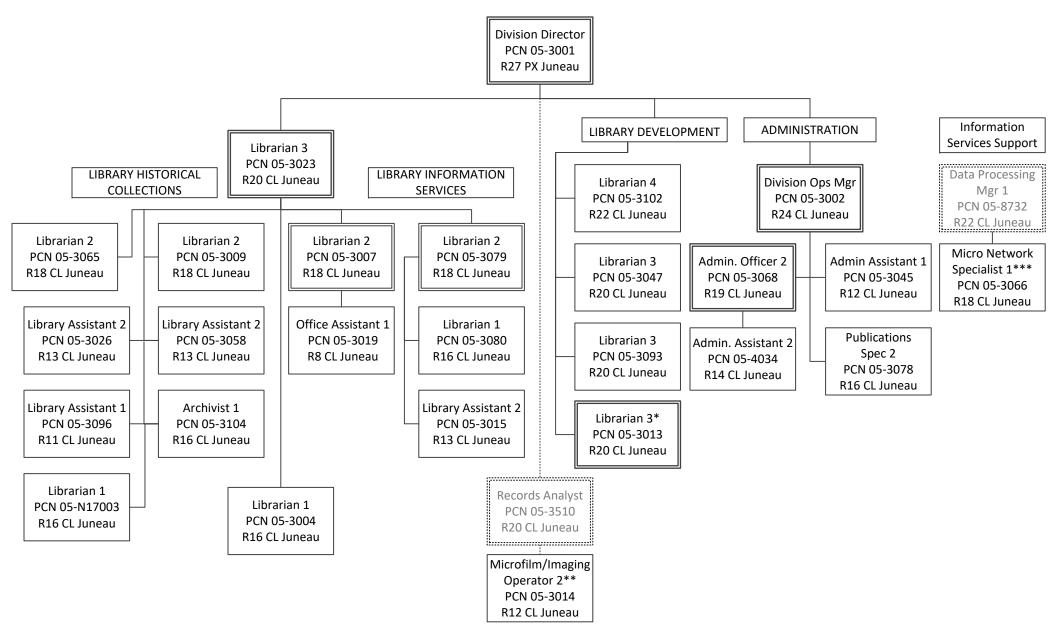
