**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

The department purchased the Bethel hangar in 1988. Renovation of a vacant adjacent space previously occupied by Civil Air Patrol is necessary to accommodate department offices, a restroom, a classroom, a transient pilot resting room and/or transient aircrew quarters, and storage. Department of Public Safety (DPS) pilots need a usable space for administrative and flight planning. The facility does not have a restroom for pilots, troopers, or prisoners.
