Examples of projects include bridge inspections, workforce development, safety education programs, inventory and condition surveys, information technology, and planning activities not funded directly with dedicated planning funding. Certain types of preventive maintenance activities are eligible for federal funding and reside within the other phasing of the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).
