Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

This project is for federal preconstruction and construction activities related to surface transportation improvements as outlined in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), funding provided by Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST), Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), and the annual federal appropriations acts. The STIP is the state's four-year program for transportation system preservation and development. It includes interstate, state, and some local highways, bridges, ferries, and public transportation, but does not include airports or non-ferry-related ports and harbors. It covers all system improvements for which partial or full federal funding is approved.

The preconstruction & construction stage of a surface transportation improvement project may include any or all of the following: reconnaissance, preliminary engineering, design, right-of-way acquisition, construction, utilities relocation activities necessary to prepare all of the documents, maps, plans, and permits required for project construction, or to provide engineering support for federally required

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programs such as the Bridge Management System or Safety Management System. These funds are used for those projects in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), the Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS) Transportation Improvement Program and the Fairbanks Metropolitan Area Transportation System (FMATS) Transportation Improvement Program.
