**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

Provide the following improvements to address safety and capacity needs within the Highway Safety Corridors: speed signs within the safety corridors on the Parks Highway, Seward Highway, Sterling Highway and Knik-Goose Bay Road. These projects contribute to the department’s mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage, and by improving the mobility of people and goods. This project provides continued surface maintenance, includes resurfacing and raising grades, dust palliative, drainage repairs, guardrail repair/replacement, and stockpiling material to ensure safety of all safety corridors in Alaska.
