*Funding Details:**The city is currently planning its CIP budget for FY25. Legislative support for this project would be paired with funding from the general fund to complete project financial requirements.***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

Funding would be used to expand and replace water and sewer infrastructure such as two new water towers, water distribution lines and other infrastructure within areas experiencing growth. Lack of capacity within the existing infrastructure is impacting growth negatively for large commercial developments in the local hospitality area. Other projects include a utility rate study and comprehensive economic development cost investing to provide utilities and road access, lighting, and pedestrian safety.

Project Timeline:

The projects would begin in FY25 (July 2024) with planning and design taking place over the summer and through the fall. Bidding would take place in the winter of 2024 and construction in summer of 2025.
