Construction

The council drilled the well and built a well house, installed electricity and plumbing.

Water quality testing and certification.

The water was tested in 2021 and found potable.

Land acquisition for new access

Private land owners have agreed to lease the needed land for public access for 99 years at the cost of one dollar.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

This project will include:

Land survey and lease agreement for the new access road.

Installation of a pitless adapter below the frost line in the existing well.

Purchase and installation of pipe extension approximately 25 feet from existing well to new access location.

Electric line extension from existing well to the new well house.

A small well house (appx 10'x10') will be built at that site.

A new access road to connect the existing public road (Wolverine) with the new well house.

This extension of water line and road is required because after the well was installed a hockey rink was built and blocks vehicular access to the well.

Better access to community water is needed to support volunteer fire suppression;
to provide safe water for homes;

to provide water for traveling tourists.

There is no public water access now. Water is only accessible through two private facilities that have allowed access to their water. Many residents use this water as their primary source for their homes and work. Private wells are often low volume or dry. New well drilling efforts in this area are often dry.

The water is used for tundra fire fighting. The council has 7 tanks with hoses and pumps on trailers.

Project Timeline:

Glacier View Community Council project will begin as soon as funding is approved and received. Ideally it will be summer and fall of 2024. All funds will be expended by the end of 2024.
