Prior Funding History / Additional Information:

The 13.5-mile Ship Creek Trail will connect two existing trails -- the recently constructed Muktuk Marston Trail and the soon-to-be realigned Indian Valley Trail -- to complete a 25.1-mile section of the Alaska Long Trail from Turnagain Arm to north Anchorage. In addition to completing a braid of the Alaska Long Trail, completion of this missing section of trail will allow more users -- including visitors, but predominantly residents - to access the heart of Chugach State Park.
