#### **Major Department Accomplishments in 2023**

- Alaska Broadband Office successfully submitted applications and was awarded planning funds under both the
  Digital Equity Planning and Broadband Equity, Access, and Development (BEAD) programs managed by the
  National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA). Total planning funds awarded in FY2023
  were \$5,567,800. In FY2025, awarded funds exceed \$1 billion.
- Alaska Seafood Marketing Institute (ASMI) executed custom promotions including social media, point of sale
  materials, product demonstrations, and merchandizing in over 36,000 U.S. retail stores and e-commerce
  platforms, in addition to partnering with over 18,000 foodservice establishments in FY2023 to include Alaska
  Seafood. ASMI expanded its ecommerce footprint to target top nationwide retailers like Kroger, Walmart and
  Whole Foods Markets with online banners, digital advertisements, imagery, influencer posts, blogs, and
  shoppable recipes.
- Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office (AMCO) met all objectives of the Title 4 Rewrite on the time schedule required by the legislation. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board rewrote all regulations to accomplish this aim and remove administrative overreach. Effective September 18, 2023, AMCO launched its new online licensing system AK-ACCIS. It continues to prepare the industry for a new regulatory structure of endorsements applying to alcoholic beverage licensees.
- Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC) continued to permit and regulate oil and gas drilling to
  prevent waste, protect correlative rights, improve ultimate recovery, and protect underground freshwater.
  Notably, the commission completed over a year-long investigation into ConocoPhillips Alaska Inc.'s gas release,
  experienced while drilling the WD-03 well on their CD1 pad. After holding a hearing on the findings, AOGCC
  issued an enforcement action with a corresponding fine.
- Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing continues to process an increased volume of licenses. The
  division continues to add online, self-serve options for applicants and licensees. All renewal applications are
  available online. The division is continually increasing the number of programs that have their initial applications
  online; nearly 70 of the division's more than 300 applications for licenses, certificates, and endorsements are
  online.

- Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority (AIDEA) in FY2023, paid the State a dividend of \$6.5 million and declared a \$17.9 million dividend for FY2024. As one of the largest investors in the State of Alaska, AIDEA has generated positive statutory net income every year since AIDEA began paying a dividend with 1997's budget process. Inclusive of this dividend, since 1997, AIDEA has declared, in aggregate more than \$464 million in dividends.
- Division of Community and Regional Affairs (DCRA) assisted 245 communities throughout Alaska. The DCRA provided urgent assistance 41 times to avoid disruption to essential public services. This resulted in 62 fuel loans to communities ineligible for bank loans and coordination of fuel deliveries to avoid critical shortages. Local Government Assistance staff provided support and assistance to rural Alaskan communities in many areas, including ensuring they submitted applications and paperwork to receive Community Assistance Program funds, Internal Revenue Services (IRS) delinquency issues, creating and tracking annual budgets, workers' compensation insurance issues. Additionally, they support disaster response and recovery following Typhoon Merbok and spring breakup flooding, training newly hired municipal and tribal staff, support running municipal and tribal elections, and much more.
- The <u>Division of Investments</u> provided patient capital to stimulate business development, job creation, and resident ownership through direct state loan origination on 162 loans and pre-qualifications totaling \$31.7 million across nine revolving loan funds.
- The Regulatory Commission of Alaska certified the first Electric reliability organization (ERO) application by the Railbelt Reliability Council (RRC) in Alaska's history by action of Order E-22-001(12) on September 23, 2022. This order capped an almost eight-year process that stands as an example of the exhaustive effort and cooperation between the commission and legislature to bolster future Alaska Railbelt Interconnected Electric Energy Transmission Network planning and reliability. Additionally, the Commission reviewed and returned the RRC's initial set of rules and began the process of reviewing the RRC's initial Tariff. The RRC is well on its way to full operations to support the Railbelt Grid.
- The <u>Alaska Energy Authority</u> and the Railbelt utilities have bonded \$166 million for Bradley Lake Hydroelectric Project (Bradley Lake) Required Project Work. These enhancements will reduce line losses, increase capacity, and improve the delivery of power from Bradley Lake to railbelt consumers. These projects will be the initial phase of some of the most significant improvements to the Railbelt electrical grid in Alaska's history. Funding for the projects comes from payments by the five railbelt utilities above those required to retire the Bradley Lake project bonds. The total cost of upgrades are estimated in the hundreds of millions.
- <u>Banking and Securities</u> collected \$22.43 million in assessments, fees, and penalties in FY2023; of which \$18.6 million was contributed to the general fund.
- <u>Insurance Operations</u> applied \$120 million in federal pass-through funds under the 1332 waiver to reinsure the individual insurance market. The program covers the cost of high-cost health conditions of Alaskans.
- <u>Administrative Services</u> identified office locations with sub-par bandwidth that limited staff productivity and public participation, and initiated physical and network upgrades to modernize internet access for impacted agencies.
- Alaska Gasline Development Corporation engaged Goldman Sachs to raise \$151 million in private equity to
  advance the project through Front End Engineering (FEED) prior to making Final Investment Decision, and to
  fine-tune the Confidential Investment Memorandum to provide information on the Alaska Liquefied Natural Gas
  (LNG) Project and the commercial offer to potential investments.

#### **Key Department Challenges**

- Efficiently licensing and regulating the rapidly growing number of professionals and businesses operating in the state:
- Providing energy infrastructure and services at a reasonable cost to Alaska communities;
- Providing coordinated support to Alaska's communities to maximize federal funding to expand broadband access across Alaska.

#### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2025

- Continuing establishment of the Alaska Broadband Office to increase broadband infrastructure throughout Alaska.
- Continuing evaluation of regulatory requirements for licensing programs across the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development to reduce unnecessary regulations and bureaucracy, and to improve efficiency.
