Component: Bethel Youth Facility

Contribution to Department's Mission

The Bethel Youth Facility provides secure detention and related services to youth who have been charged or adjudicated of an offense and are awaiting adjudication or further court action; services for youth who have been committed to the facility for long-term secure treatment; and transition/aftercare services to offenders being released from secure treatment.

Detention services include a 12-bed secure co-ed detention program. The program provides supervision, and custody and care services for accused and adjudicated delinquent youth.

Treatment services include an 11-bed secure treatment program. The treatment program provides supervision, custody and care, long-term treatment, and transitional services for adjudicated delinquent youth.

Core Services

- Core services for detention include operations, detention/stabilization services, and education/skill development.
- Core services for treatment include operations, treatment/transitional services, and education/vocational services.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2023

Bethel Youth Facility Treatment conducted two culture camps and a cultural educational hunt. The camps teach a variety of traditional skills still prevalent in many rural communities. Facility youth and staff harvested and butchered a moose for future use in facility cooking projects. This was done in compliance with Department of Environmental Conservation approved guidelines.

Bethel Youth Facility resumed Cultural Heritage week; the youth participated in various cooking projects, making beaver fur hats, kuspuks, ice fishing sticks, practiced Native Youth Olympics, beading, lure making, and prepared ducks for soup. This was the first full cultural heritage week since 2020, after being paused due to COVID-19.

The facility's camera system was upgraded to be in line with the division's other facilities. This upgrade improves the safety of staff and youth.

The installation of sound paneling was completed in the Bethel Youth Facility gymnasium. This increases the safety of the space for youth and staff. The noise level without sound panels can be over stimulating for youth with fetal alcohol spectrum disorder or triggering for some youth with significant trauma histories.

Key Component Challenges

The Bethel Youth Facility continued to see recruitment challenges, including the lack of a maintenance generalist. This position has remained vacant since FY2022, with a potential hire for FY2024.

The sewer system has faced continuous issues, a temporary solution is in place and construction is set for this spring. Additionally, the fenced area surrounding the facility has seen drainage issues. Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Consortium has partnered with Bethel Youth Facility for one solution; however, it is anticipated the issue will be ongoing.

New construction of a community hotel has compromised the safety and confidentiality for youth using the outdoor recreation area. The new hotel looks directly into the facility yard and severely impacts outdoor activities; the department is examining options to remedy this matter.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2025

Continued increased elder involvement within the facility is an identified area for improvement and will be a focus over the coming year.
