In cooperation with organizations like the U.S. Geological Survey, University of Alaska Fairbanks, University of Alaska Anchorage, University of Alaska Southeast, and Department of Natural Resources - Division of Geological and Geophysical Surveys, this program conducts studies to analyze hydrologic flood conditions. Additionally, airborne survey technologies are utilized to track river ice accumulations during winter months.
