Federal Receipts from Alaska Transportation Infrastructure Bank

Project Description/Justification:

This project provides the State of Alaska the opportunity to leverage designated general fund (DGF) revenues generated from the sale or lease of excess property that was originally purchased with federal funds. Under federal law, this can only be used on Title 23 eligible activities. Title 23 eligible uses of this funding include, but are not limited to: construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, restoration, rehabilitation, and preservation of highways and bridges; construction, rehabilitation, or replacement of existing ferry boats and facilities, including approaches, that connect road segments; bridge and tunnel inspection and evaluation, as well as the training of bridge and tunnel inspectors; and highway safety projects.
