Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

The Department of Environmental Conservation requests federal receipt authority to receive and expend federal grants applied for from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Drinking Water Infrastructure Improvement for the Nation Act (WIIN) associated with the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA). The IIJA includes a total of \$5 billion for the Emerging Contaminants in Small or Disadvantaged Communities (ECSDC) grant program, which focuses on addressing emerging contaminants in drinking water served by public water systems in small or disadvantaged communities.
