Project Description/Justification:

The Annex is vital for the training of soldiers assigned to three deployable units stationed there. The dining facility does not meet current health code requirements. Upgrades are needed to provide a safe, sanitary food preparation area for soldiers to avoid food borne illnesses and other health related issues and is not usable by the 297th Field Feeding Detachment. The ability to feed soldiers and responders to disasters on-site is critical to operations. Additionally, the road that connects the lower to upper armory complex requires paving to permit safe travel of military vehicles, decrease risk of washout, and reduce future maintenance costs. Finally, the Alcantra Armory is not visible from the road, and the current sign is inadequate and isn't located where the new complex entrance is located. Increasing visibility to the Alaska Army National Guard has a direct impact on the recruiting efforts. The condition of these areas at Alcantra has a detrimental effect on the ability to sustain responders and civil authorities during disaster responses.
