Department of Transportation and Public Facilities Information Systems and Services Component Budget Summary

Component: Information Systems and Services

Contribution to Department's Mission

This component houses the department's line-of-business information technology (IT) staff who specialize in Department of Transportation and Public Facilities software applications as well as provides other department specific information technology and software.

Core Services

- Provide IT expertise for department specific software projects and implementation.
- Provide maintenance, support, and management of legacy department specific applications.
- Provide database and software design services.
- Provide assistance and specific solution designs for migrating legacy applications to Microsoft Azure.
- Monitor and manage cloud services consumption from a technical and financial perspective.
- Collaborate and provide translation and liaison services for the department when working with the Office of Information Technology.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2024

- Strengthened Remote Connectivity: Successfully deployed Starlink satellite internet to over twenty remote sites, significantly enhancing communication and operational capabilities in hard-to-reach locations. This effort has improved service delivery in rural areas and played a vital role during natural disaster responses, allowing the department to support cutting-edge response strategies and maintain public safety.
- Modernized Fleet IT Infrastructure: Upgraded the Alaska Marine Highway System (AMHS) fleet's IT systems, including critical databases and vessel maintenance systems. By transitioning to modern platforms, the department has improved fleet operations, ensuring this essential service for coastal communities operates more efficiently, with reduced downtime and better resource management.
- Improved Project Management Capabilities: Migrated all department software projects to Atlassian Cloud Jira for centralized project tracking. This transition has enhanced oversight, transparency, and accountability across divisions, leading to improved project outcomes, more efficient resource allocation, and better fiscal responsibility in managing State projects.
- Upgraded Statewide IT Collaboration: Updated conference room technology with advanced Polycom systems, facilitating better statewide collaboration through improved video conferencing capabilities. These upgrades allow for more seamless communication between field offices and central management, reducing the need for travel and improving operational efficiency across the State.
- Key Infrastructure Modernization: Migrated department-wide Windows file shares to NetApp file shares, improving
 data management and accessibility while strengthening security and compliance. This modernization effort
 ensures that critical departmental data is stored in a secure, scalable, and easily accessible manner, improving
 workflow efficiency and collaboration.

Key Component Challenges

- Recruiting and Retaining Skilled IT Professionals: Attracting and retaining qualified technical staff is a persistent challenge. Competitive pressures from the private sector, coupled with geographic and compensation-related barriers, make it difficult to fill critical IT positions.
- Legacy Systems Impeding Progress: The department continues to rely on several outdated legacy systems that
 are increasingly difficult to maintain. These systems hinder our ability to adopt more efficient, cloud-based
 technologies, limiting the department's capacity to improve operational efficiency and service delivery to the
 public.
- Undersized IT Workforce: The department's IT team is currently too small to meet the growing demands of technology-driven initiatives. This resource constraint puts pressure on existing staff and slows the progress of critical modernization efforts, posing a risk to long-term departmental efficiency.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2026

- Completion of Alaska Marine Highway Scheduling System: Finalize the development and deployment of a new scheduling application for the AMHS. This system will optimize route planning, improve the management of resources, and provide better services to the communities that depend on this essential transportation network. By improving the efficiency of the AMHS, we aim to reduce operational costs and enhance service reliability.
- Deployment of Cloud-Based Oversize/Overweight Vehicle Permitting System: Launch a modern cloud-hosted
 permitting system for oversize and overweight vehicles. This system will streamline the application process for
 businesses, reducing processing time and increasing transparency. By moving this vital function to the cloud, we
 will enhance operational efficiency and ease of access for the transportation industry.
- Transition to Windows 11 and Cloud Storage: Complete the migration of all department staff computers to
 Windows 11 and shift home folder data to Microsoft OneDrive. These upgrades will improve security,
 performance, and compatibility while aligning the department with modern cybersecurity standards, ensuring that
 our systems are prepared for the evolving digital landscape.
- Onboarding of Mobile Device Management (MDM) Solutions: Onboard the OIT MDM system to manage and secure mobile devices across the department. This will allow for more efficient control over staff-assigned phones and tablets, improving data security and ensuring that employees can work effectively and securely in the field.
- Recruitment and Training Initiatives: Strengthen the department by recruiting highly skilled technical staff and
 expanding training opportunities for existing employees. These initiatives will ensure that we maintain a talented
 workforce capable of meeting the department's growing technology needs while enhancing customer service and
 operational efficiency.

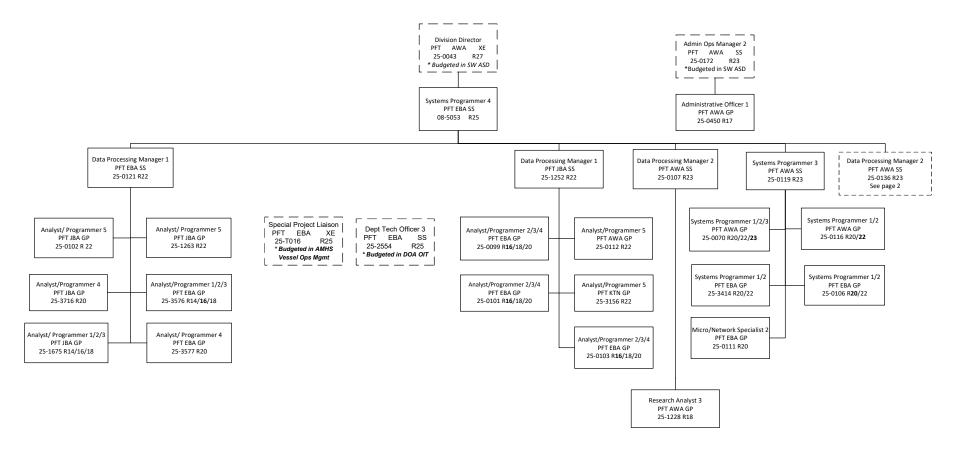
