Component: Fairbanks Airport Facilities

Contribution to Department's Mission

Protect the State's investment in the Fairbanks International Airport's (FAI) buildings by maintaining, in the most cost-effective manner possible, infrastructure, utilities, structures, non-State of Alaska (SOA) networks and other facilities to meet their expected life cycle at an acceptable level of service, and to always present a clean and attractive passenger terminal and other airport facilities to the traveling public, airport tenants, and employees.

Core Services

- Operate and maintain the airport terminal buildings, field maintenance facilities, aircraft rescue and firefighting facility, and all other facilities at the FAI.
- Operate and maintain heating, ventilation and air conditioning climate systems, baggage conveyor systems, escalators and elevators, automated doors and gates, interior lighting systems, surface finishing, exterior electrical systems including runway and taxiway lights, aircraft tie-downs, vehicle parking, electrical outlets, and floodlights.
- Operate, maintain, and secure all non-SOA information technology (IT) and operational technology (OT) networks and monitor cyber security of OT networks. OT networks include airfield lighting controls, close circuit television (CCTV), access control security, heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC), and baggage handling and screening.
- Coordinate both tenant and State sponsored construction, renovations, repairs, and small projects.
- Landscaping around the passenger terminal, public parking and air park campground; provide multiple daily
 cleaning cycles in the passenger terminal, other airport buildings, the air park campground, and private pilots
 lounge.
- Ice remediation and removing snow from sidewalks and walkways during the winter.
- Maintain artwork and tend flower gardens.
- Ensure cleanliness and sanitization of the terminal to prevent the spread of communicable diseases.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2024

- Continued upgrade of existing fluorescent fixtures to light-emitting diodes (LEDs) throughout FAI terminal.
- Completed roof leak repair project for the Airport Response Center.
- Upgraded FAI Time and Temp sign with new FAI logo and LED lighting.
- Upgraded South Cargo Apron area stadium lighting to LED.
- Facilitated the transition to the Amadeus Customer Use System for FAI's shared Common Use Passenger Processing System counters, ensuring readiness for the summer season.
- Upgraded the fire alarm panel at the Airport Maintenance Facility.

Key Component Challenges

- Recruitment and retention challenges continue to persist in skilled positions.
- Reported Notice of Pay Problems for Labor, Trades & Crafts staff have continued to increase at a faster rate than they are being resolved.
- Increased costs for contracts, consumable supplies, and parts.
- Difficulty procuring parts for older systems, with shorter life cycles on systems and equipment requiring replacements.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2026

- Baggage handling systems software and server upgrades.
- Milestone CCTV Server Upgrade
- FAI State network server upgrades to include redundant server for security.
- Passenger Boarding Bridge 3 replacement project.
