The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) awards grants to respond to and mitigate impacts of State natural disasters. Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery funds may be used for preventative measures to avoid potential impacts to communities. This appropriation will allow the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development to receive incoming disaster recovery funds in a timely manner, improving the timeliness of deploying funding to impacted communities.

Project Description/Justification:

The Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery awards are administered through a multi-phase process that involves the creation and submission of an Administrative Action Plan, Unmet Needs Assessment, Public Action Plan, and Implementation Plan, all of which must be submitted to HUD for approval.

This appropriation will allow the department to accelerate the HUD approval process by beginning program development as soon as disaster recovery awards are announced, which will ultimately

reduce the time to program deployment.
