The Governor's fiscal year (FY) 2026 budget included \$733,000 in matching general funds for the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant. However, only the federal receipt authority was appropriated. To utilize the \$1,100,000 awarded in federal funds, matching funds are required. Due to lower-than-expected match requirements in prior years, the required match amount for FY2026 has been significantly reduced.
